

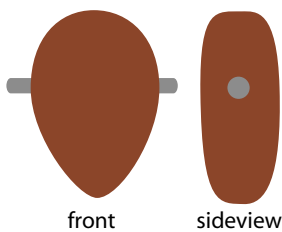
Tutorial Rudolph

Used colours:

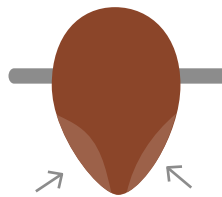
brown
black (for the pupils)
white (for the eyes)
light ivory (inside ears and horns)
Red (for the nose)



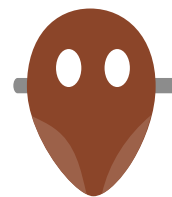
Description:



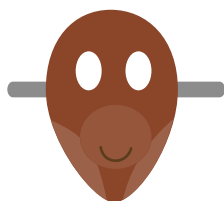
Make a drop-shaped basebead out of the lightbrown glass and flatten it. Make sure that the ends are nice and round.



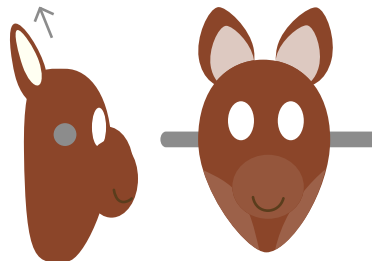
Heat the bottom left side and push it with your paddle. Do the same at the bottom right side to form a chin and cheeks.



Place white dots for the eyes, melt the dots flat and rake them till they are oval shaped.



Place a large Brown dot for a snout and melt the connection smooth. Heat the front and give Rudolph his smile. You can do that with a knife or the bottom part of ruffle pliers if you have one.



Place brown dots as ears and flatten those. Put ivory dots on top of them, heat them and flatten again. Shape them with your ruffle pliers or a knife. Heat again and pull them pointy shape.



Stack small dots on top of each other to form his horns, place a red dot as Rudolph's red nose. Melt it in a bit, so it adheres well. Give Rudolph a view on the world by placing pupils in his eyes. Melt them in a bit, so they adhere well.
